Entry and Camping Passes will be issued to pilots and helpers in early August once the booking and slotting arrangements have been finalised.

All models over 20 Kgs must have the required CAA exemption, a copy of which must be provided with the completed form. The original must then be presented to the Display Director at the event. Note models will be weighed as part of the compliance and safety checks as part of the booking in and processing procedure.
